FMC completed closure of RCRA hazardous waste unit #5 (the Slag Pit Sump) on October 31, 2005 and units #15 (Pond 18), #14 (Pond 17) on November 22, 2005 at the FMC Idaho LLC, Pocatello facility. Pursuant to the EPA-approved RCRA closure plans for Pond 18, Pond 17, and the Slag Pit Sump, enclosed please find the certifications that the closures were completed in accordance with the respective closure plans. Documentation supporting the certifications, the Closure Reports (for) Pond 18, Pond 17, and the Slag Pit Sump dated December 2005, are enclosed.

Pursuant to the respective post-closure plans, FMC has recorded the required notices to the deed that the land use is restricted and has recorded the survey plats (as required under 40 CFR 265.116) depicting the closure area at Pond 18 Cell A, Pond 17, and the Slag Pit Sump. Enclosed please find a copy of the recorded "Notice and Covenants Restricting Use of Property" and survey plat for Pond 18 Cell A, Pond 17, and the Slag Pit Sump, respectively. In addition, FMC filed the deed notices and survey plats with local authorities, specifically the State Emergency Response Committee (SERC) and the District V Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC). A copy of the letter that transmitted these documents to the SERC and LEPC is enclosed.

FMC has initiated required post-closure monitoring and maintenance at Pond 18 Cell A, Pond 17, and the Slag Pit Sump per the post closure plan component of the approved Pond 18, Pond 17, and the Slag Pit Sump closure plans, respectively.



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Finally, FMC anticipates that a separate request will be forwarded to EPA Region 10 requesting a reduction in the RCRA financial assurance for the facility in recognition of completion of the closure of Pond 18, Pond 17, and the Slag Pit Sump.
